This is an "Operation Iraqi Freedom" investigation.

This investigation was initiated upon notification from the 391st Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN) Operations Section, BCCF, Abu Ghryeb, IZ, that Detainee AWAD died.

Investigation established probable cause to believe Detainee AWAD died as a result of Severe Atherosclerotic Coronary Vascular Disease and the manner of death was natural.

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: On 11 May 04, this office was notified by the 391st Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN) Operations, Baghdad Correctional Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghruyeb, Iraq (AGI), that Detainee Hussein Abdullah AWAD AL JUWADI, National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) #159756, died.

About 1610, 11 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* interviewed COL (DR) *7C-3 bb-3* 848th Forward Surgical Team (FST), BCCF, AGI, who stated AWAD was brought into the hospital at 1455, 11 May 04, after falling out during a camp inspection. COL *7bb-3* stated resuscitation efforts were being preformed prior to arrival at the hospital. He stated the efforts continued until 1515 hrs, when AWAD was pronounced dead. COL *7bb-3* stated the cause of death was Acute Miocardial Infarction (heart Attack). COL *7Cbb-3* stated he observed no sign of injury or abuse.

About 1625, 11 May 04, SA *7C-1 bb-1* exposed photographs of deceased using a Fuji film Digital Camera. (See Compact Disc)

AGENT'S COMMENT: This agent saw no signs of physical abuse on the body of the deceased.

About 1715, 11 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* coordinated with SFC *7C-3 bb-3* 391st MP BN, Prisoner In-Processing Section, BCCF, AGI, and observed the positive ID of AWAD using a retinal scan. (See Dossier)

About 0830, 12 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* interviewed SFC *7C-3 bb-3* 391st MP BN, BCCF, AGI, who stated at about 1130, 11 May 04 a decision was made to do a complete camp inspection of Ganci #2, due to a previous altercation between two detainees which involved a weapon. He stated at 1145, 11 May 04, the detainees were consolidated into the holding area. At approximately 1340, 11 May 04 (unsure about the time), several detainees started waving for help and brought AWAD to the entrance of Ganci #2. He stated medics then began treatment of AWAD.

About 0850, 12 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* interviewed Detainee *7CF-3 bb-3* NDRS *7CF, bb-3* Ganci #2 Camp Chief, who stated he knew Detainee AWAD was a diabetic and had high blood pressure.

About 0900, 12 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* interviewed HM3 *7C-3 bb-3* K Co., 3 BN, 24 Marines, AGI, who stated he was the medic on scene who treated Detainee AWAD. He stated Detainee AWAD was unconscious with a thready pulse and shallow breathing. He immediately called for a medical transport. He said CPR was performed for approximately 10 minutes as well as additional medical aid prior to being transported to the hospital.

About 0940, 12 May 04, SA *7C1 bb-1* with the assistance of Interpreter *7C-3 bb-3*, this office, interviewed Detainee *7CF-3 bb-3* NDRS *7CFbb-3*, who stated AWAD was diabetic and had high blood pressure. He stated while standing in the holding area of Ganci #2, AWAD

began to defecate on the ground and soon fell to the ground unconscious. He said he assisted other detainees in carrying AWAD to the front gate.

About 1430, 12 May 04, SA *7C-1 bb-1* coordinated with SGT *7C-3 bb-3* 391st MP BN Aid Station, BCCF, AGI, and obtained the death certificate pertaining to Detainee AWAD. (See Death Certificate)

About 1445, 12 May 04, SA *7C-1 bb-1* obtained the medical records of Detainee AWAD which revealed a prior history of diabetes and high blood pressure. (See Records)

On 14 Jun 04, SA *7C-1 bb-1* received the Information Report from the 75th MP Detachment, LSA Anaconda, Balad. (See AIR of SA *7C-1 bb-1*)

On 14 May 04, this office received telephonic Request For Assistance (RFA) from the 75th MP Det, Abu Ghurayb, APO AE 09335, in reference to Report of Investigation (ROI) 0033-04-CID789-83985, to attend the autopsy of Mr. Awad Al-Juwadi HUSSIEN, ISN 159756.

About 0330, 17 May 04, SA 7C-1 bb-1 CDR (Dr). 7C-3 bb-3 USN, Deputy Medical Examiner, Armed Forces Medical Examiner (AFIP), and HM1 7C-3 bb-3 Forensic Photographer, AFIP, arrived at the Mortuary Affairs Processing Area, LSA Anaconda, Balad, Iraq, APO AE 09391, to autopsy the remains of Mr. HUSSIEN.

AGENTS COMMENT: The remains of Mr. HUSSIEN were too frozen at the time to autopsy. HM1 7C-3 bb-3 exposed digital images of Mr. HUSSIEN's remains.

Between 1115 and 1430, Dr. 7C-3 bb-3 conducted a forensic autopsy of Mr. HUSSIEN. SA 7C-1 bb-1 collected finger prints of Mr. HUSSIEN.

About 1600, 18 May 04, Dr. 7C-3 bb-3 provided a preliminary autopsy report regarding Mr. HUSSIEN (see Preliminary Autopsy Report for details).

About 1610, 18 May 04, HM1 7C-3 bb-3 provided copies of digital images regarding the forensic autopsy of Mr. HUSSIEN.

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ON 14 JUN 04, THIS OFFICE RECEIVED THE PRELIMINARY AUTOPSY REPORT FROM THE ARMED FORCES INSTITUTE OF PATHOLOGY, ROCKVILLE, MD, WHICH LISTED THE MANNER OF DEATH AS NATURAL AND THE CAUSE OF DEATH AS SEVERE ATHEROSCLEROTIC CORONARY VASCULAR DISEASE.

INITIAL:
