6. INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY: THE INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT  
IS BASED UPON AN ALLEGATION OR PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION  
AND MAY CHANGE PRIOR TO THE COMPLETION OF THE  
INVESTIGATION.

THIS IS AN "OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM" INVESTIGATION.

THIS REPORT WAS DELAYED AS A RESULT OF CONDITIONS NORMALLY  
ASSOCIATED WITH AN OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENT, AND THE DELAY  
THIS CAUSED IN IDENTIFYING THE REMAINS OF MR. SUDHAIL.

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ON 27 MAY 2004, THE 22<sup>ND</sup> MP BN WAS NOTIFIED OF THE DEATH OF A DETAINEE IDENTIFIED ONLY BY THE NUMBER [REDACTED] (MR. SUDHAIL), BY THE MORTUARY AFFAIRS COLLECTION POINT, BAGHDAD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BIAP), IRAQ. *b(6)4 b(7)(c)4*

INVESTIGATION ESTABLISHED ON 29 APRIL 2004, MR. SUDHAIL WAS INVOLVED IN AN ATTACK AGAINST ELEMENTS OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup> MARINE EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, IN THE FALLUJAH, IRAQ AREA AND WAS WOUNDED DURING THE ATTACK. HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY EVACUATED TO THE MEDICAL TREATMENT FACILITY LOCATED AT THE BAGHDAD CENTRAL CONFINEMENT FACILITY, ABU GHRAIB, IRAQ FOR TREATMENT.

ON 21 MAY 2004, MR. SUDHAIL WAS TRANSFERRED TO THE 31<sup>ST</sup> CSH, WHERE HE SUBSEQUENTLY DIED ON 24 MAY 04. MR. SUDHAIL WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD BY DR. (CPT) [REDACTED] (NFI).

ON 1 JUNE 2004, DR. (MAJ) [REDACTED] ARMED FORCES INSTITUTE OF PATHOLOGY, ROCKVILLE, MD CONDUCTED AN AUTOPSY OF MR. SUDHAIL'S REMAINS, AND DETERMINED THE CAUSE OF DEATH WAS PERITONITIS AS A CONSEQUENCE OF A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE ABDOMEN. *b(6)3 b(7)(c)3*

ON 15 JUNE 2004, INFORMATION WAS OBTAINED THAT IDENTIFIED PRISONER [REDACTED] AS MR. SUDHAIL.

THE CASUALTY LIAISON OFFICER IS CW3 [REDACTED] ASSISTANT OPERATIONS OFFICER, 22<sup>ND</sup> MP BN (CID), BIAP, IZ. *b(6)1 b(7)(c)1*

THIS OFFICE ANTICIPATES NO FURTHER INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT, AS THE INFORMATION DEVELOPED TO DATE INDICATE MR. SUDHAIL WAS INVOLVED IN AN ATTACK ON COALITION FORCES WHEN HE WAS WOUNDED.

7. COMMANDERS ARE REMINDED OF THE PROVISIONS OF AR 600-8-2 PERTAINING TO SUSPENSION OF FAVORABLE PERSONNEL ACTIONS AND AR 300-67 FOR THE SUSPENSION OF SECURITY CLEARANCES OF PERSONS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

About 24 May 2004, the undersigned was notified by personnel from the Mortuary Affairs collection point of an unidentified set of remains who had recently arrived. The remains were that of an Iraqi Detainee, identified only by the number [REDACTED]. Information from the MACP personnel indicated the unidentified male had been involved in an attack against coalition forces, and had been wounded. He subsequently died of his wounds after being transferred to the 31<sup>st</sup> Combat Support Hospital, LSA Anaconda, Iraq. The MACP personnel did not know where the individual was wounded or how he came to be at the 31<sup>st</sup> CSH.

About 27 May 04, the undersigned attempted to ascertain if any of the detachments in the 22<sup>nd</sup> had any information on the detainee known only by the number [REDACTED]. All attempts to determine the identity met with negative results.

About 14 June 04, the undersigned was notified by the MACP that they had received medical records pertaining to detainee [REDACTED]. Obtained a copy of the medical records, which further identified the detainee by Internment Serial Number (ISN) [REDACTED].

About 15 June 04, the undersigned received information from the Special Agent in Charge, 78<sup>th</sup> MP Det (CID), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility, that further identified the detainee. According to information from a SIR obtained by SAC [REDACTED] the detainee is named Ibrahim Hamadan SUDHAIL, ISN [REDACTED] (NFI). Mr. SUDHAIL was injured while involved with a fire-fight against Marines in the Marine AOR. He was transferred directly to the BCCF hospital, treated and eventually transferred to the 31<sup>st</sup> Combat Support Hospital (CSH), LSA Anaconda. He died there on 24 May 04.
